



Curriculum Detail: IFS Certificate in Financial Education

This Level 2 course, available to Year 11 students, provides an introduction to the economy, financial management skills, employability and enterprise.

CeFE introduces the student to the impact of finance on the economy and encourages them to consider how this can affect businesses and individuals. It aids the development of a valuable range of applied and transferable skills and provides a foundation for further study in business and finance-related disciplines as well as other fields encapsulated in programmes of study related to social enterprise and vocational professional development.

Students take three mandatory units: Finance, the Individual and Society; Practices of Managing Money; and Financial Capability, Work and Enterprise.
